TASTING NOTES, NOVA 7

In the glass, a pale salmon with orange hue. The nose is delicately perfumed, thanks to a myriad of white flowers and passion fruit. On the palate, the wine immediately refreshes, with tonic notes of key lime, mango and green apples. An invigorating wine, finding balance between engaging floral aromatics and energizing acidity.

In the glass, a pale salmon with an amber hue. On the nose, hints of magnolia, lychee and passion fruit are electrified by brisk citrus undertones. The palate is pure and highly energetic, with a cascade of fresh lime, green apples and ripe mangoes echoing in a most refreshing finish.
